Design and create large scale models using recycled waste materials

Understanding the World



Places and People – use an atlas or globe to locate where dinosaur fossils have been found
Design a map to lead a lost dinosaur from our school What features will it pass on the way?

Time and People – discuss changes caused by time. What do you think the earth looked like when dinosaurs roamed? How is it different now?

Myself and Other Living Things – group dinosaurs according to observations e.g. horns/no horns, walks on 2 legs/walks on 4 legs etc.

Myself and Non-Living Things – freeze mini dinosaurs in ice and investigate how to free them. Exploring fossils and deciding which animal they might belong to.
