What to do when you don't know what to do? Make time to implement strategies to aid children to become more independent learners in maths – what resources do I need? Etc. Analyse school tracking each term, putting in place and providing intervention for those children who are borderline entering each year group. A mixture of gap, catch up and pre-teach intervention. Question analysis of 2019 Maths SATs papers and KLIPs analysis to help determine areas of weakness. Book scrutiny - look for
