On Monday, the Year 6 children took part in Bikeability training and they all passed! The training ranged in different levels from cycling skills in the playground to riding safely on the roads around Hornby. All children gained in confidence throughout the training which was lovely to see.

"Today at Bikeability we learnt how to keep safe on a main road, who has priority on the road, for instance the bigger the vehicle, the less priority they have. Firstly, we looked and checked that our bike was fit to ride. We learnt about how to check the 'M' shape. Next, we cycled around the playground to learn how to indicate and how to do a sudden stop. Then we went on the roads around Hornby. We stopped a few times to talk about 'U' turns."
