

Places are now available to join a new 12-week football course every Friday at Salt Ayre Leisure centre which is open to both boys and garls.

Our courses teach children correct football techniques by FA qualified coaches who have full DBS (CRB) clearance to work with children. The structure for the course is FUN through Football, building confidence for total beginners and moving own more complex sessions for experienced players.

We provide a ball per player for the majerity of our drills ensuring children get more touches of the ball and improve quicker than conventional coaching where children are waiting around to have a turn. The sessions are held on the fantastic grass pitch so boots should be worn. Players are also advised to being a still drink for the session.

The club has links to local junior teams of which players will be able to play for at the weekend. Players who show advanced ability on the course will be recommended for trials at professional academies. Players who have previously attended coarses are currently playing for Preston North End. Blackburn Rovers, Manchester United, Liverpool, Blackpool, Everton, Burnley, Bolton, Oldham, Rachdale and Wigan.

The cost of the course is just 6.25 per week, which is payable in two instalments. The first payment of £25 is due when booking your child on and the accound payment of £50 due at the first session. Parents are encouraged to watch the sessions but are welcome to leave children, as every aexism is fully supervised.

NEW TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Every four weeks we have a tournament in order for the children to put their new-found skills into practice with medals awarded at the end of the course for various categories.

ALL PLAYERS WILL RECEIVE A TROPHY AND MEDAL at the presentation, which is held on the final week of the course. Additional trophics will also be awarded in each group from categories including. Best Attitude, Stat Player, Most Improved Player, Most Promising Player and Hardest Working Player.
