This week in KS2, we have been on a visit to St Margaret's church, where Rev Lucie demonstrated the Eucharist service and explained all the symbols and objects associated with it. We then had Rev Emma, our local Methodist Minister come into school and explain how the Holy Communion is celebrated in a Methodist Church and what the similarities and differences are. Finally, we had our own Mrs. Harvey discussing her experiences of Mass within a Roman Catholic Church. The children asked some excellent questions and even tried some of the wafers and grape juice. Thank you to Rev Lucie, Rev Emma and Mrs. Harvey for giving up their time and knowledge - it was lovely to have some extra 'teachers' explaining things to the children.
