Long Term Plan for Religious Education (RE)

Religious education in a Church school should enable every child to flourish and to live life in all its fullness. (John 10:10). It will help educate for dignity and respect encouraging all to live well together.

Religious Education in Church of England Schools, February 2019

- RE should receive at least 5% of class time, which equates to 45 hours per year in KS2 and 36 hours in KS1.
- 70% (25¼hrs in KS1 and 31½hrs in KS2) of this time will be dedicated to the study of Christianity. These are shown in black text on the long-term plans below.
- 30% of RE teaching time (10%hrs in KS1 and 13½hrs in KS2) should be spent looking at world faiths to include the study of Buddhism, Hinduism, Islam, Judaism and Sikhism as well as non-religious world views such as Humanism. These are shown in red text on the long-term plans shown below. The orange text indicates the big questions for world faiths.
- By the end of Year 6, we aim to have provided our children with a good knowledge and understanding of Christianity, Islam, Hinduism and Judaism. In addition, we aim to ensure pupils will have also encountered aspects of Buddhism, Sikhism and World Views (Humanism).
- Children in the Early Years Foundation Stage should always have access to continuous provision linked to their RE learning and this will contribute towards some of their recommended hours.
