This week in KS1 the children have enjoyed painting in the style of local artist Chas Jacobs, they were practicing their colour mixing starting with primary colours and creating secondary colours to use in their artwork. In music they have been creating their own soundscape of Hornby using percussion instruments and their vocals for extra sound effects.

The children have produced some wonderful English work this week and created their own alternative fairytales. Some of the stories have included The 3 kind bunnies and The 3 tiny hamsters. The children have been developing their sentences and descriptive writing to produce some fabulous stories.

KS2 started the week with a very informative workshop provided by Brockhole from the Lake District about water. They learnt how much water an activity such as brushing your teeth or flushing the toilet uses and then calculated approximately how much they would use in a day. There were quite a few differences between the totals - some only admitted going to the toilet twice in a day or even having only one shower over the week or never washing their hands after going to the toilet!

The children then looked at what they could do to save water and hopefully they have come home with some ideas, which could help to reduce your water bills.

Some of the children have been working with Olivia, from Where The Wildings to help build a large bug hotel in our quiet area in the school grounds. They had fun yesterday understanding what natural materials 'bugs' like to live in and have started the build! We look forward to seeing the finished result and hope the 'bugs' will enjoy their five star hotel.
