In KS1 we have been learning about animals in different habitats. We have done some research on animals under the sea and we have measured in grams and ml to make salt dough sea animals. As part of our English lessons in KS2 this week, the children have been researching about the Awa tribe. These are indigenous people living in the Amazon rainforest. They are known as one of the last nomadic hunter-gatherer tribes and are considered one of the most endangered tribes on Earth due to threats from illegal logging. The children have used their gathered information to complete some amazing factual and eye-catching posters. In our math's lessons, LKS2 have been naming and stating the properties of 2D shapes, including triangles and a range of quadrilaterals. They were amazed at how many different shapes we have.
